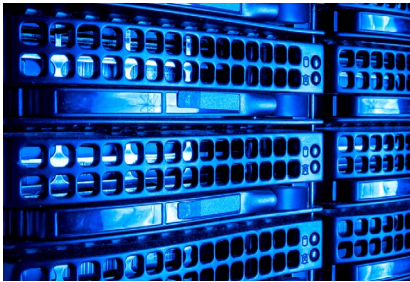

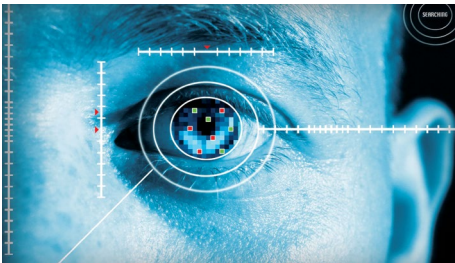

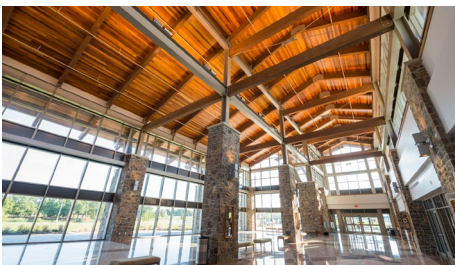

The partnership advances Walter Reed’s mission of protecting and sustaining the health of the U.S. military through new drugs and vaccines; supporting global infectious diseases surveillance; completing detailed pathogen and disease descriptions; and educating the next generation of world class scientists and research support personnel.
